1. Horseshoe Market

- **Overview**: A Flea Market that focuses on local handmade goods that can be sold at their seasonal events.

- **When and Where:** Summer Market at Breckenridge Brewery in Littleton on Saturday August 5. The address is 2920 Brewery Ln Littleton, Colorado.
- **Length:** Only one day from 10am-4pm
- Vendor Application: <u>Vendor Application Horseshoe Market</u>- Application for the Summer Market is not up yet. The application covers what type of products you are selling, if you have a website or social media account, a description of your product, and booth selection and pricing. The application is free.
- **Application Deadline:** TBD
- What they are looking for: Horseshoe focuses on vintage, handmade, or repurposed products that are unique and of high quality.
- **Requirements:** State of Colorado Special Events License
- **Percentage of sales:** n/a
- **Perks:** Horseshoe Market has a large social media presence and, if you are selected to be a vendor, will showcase your booth on their social media accounts. **An exceptionally large exposure for your business.**

2. Artisan Center

- **When are Where:** Every day at the Artisan center at 2757 E 3rd Ave in the Cherry Creek area of Denver.
- **Length:** People can shop from 10am-5pm

- **Vendor Application:** No application available but you need to reach out through email at **info@artisancenterdenver.com**. In the email, be sure to include information about yourself, your art, include photos, and price point.
- **Application Deadline:** None
- What they are looking for: The Artisan Center values art and craftables that are unique and well made. This can be jewelry, handmade soaps, any kind of décor, etc.
- **Requirements**: n/a
- **Percentage of Sales:** n/a
- **Perks:** Popular arts and crafts store in the heart of Cherry Creek. The store sees a large flow of foot traffic daily. **Your business will have a significant amount of exposure from selling through Artisan Center**

3. Denver Bazaar

- Overview: Large community market for Denver. A considerable number of vendors and events year-round. You can sell artisanal products at their weekly events.
- **Contact information:** vending@gumpoppresents.com/
- When are Where: People and Produce at Belleview Station will go from June 4 all the way to September 24. The Bazaar is found at 2845 Walnut St here in Denver.
- **Length:** 9am-1pm.
- Vendor Application: Click on 2023 events and click on People and Produce. Scroll
 through vending options, add to cart, and fill out the vendor registration form that
 comes with it. Afterwards, complete your online payment.
- **Application Deadline:** n/a
- What they are looking for: Denver Bazaar is wanting local, ethical, and handmade products to be sold at this event. Vendors must submit information about their products, any website information they possess, and photos during the vendor registration process.
- Requirements: Each vendor is required to sign the 2023 Vendor Agreement and upload a proof of insurance, business license, and sales tax license.
- **Percentage of Sales:** 10%
- **Perks:** Massive foot traffic, large exposure of your business, and the ability to meet and connect with other local businesses as well.
- **Vendor Prices/ Info:** Drop in (One Day) 10x10 \$30

10x20 \$40

- You can have a booth for one day only for half or more of the event.

4. Mile High Flea Market

- **Overview:** A large open space marketplace where vendors can sell their products.

- **Contact information:** (303)-289-4656
- **When are Where:** Found at 7007 E 88th Avenue. Two events, one for Free Admission Friday June 30 and Family Fun Fest on July 15. Also, every weekend you can sell your products.
- **Length:** 7am-5pm. Can set up at 8:30am and leave before 6pm.
- **Vendor Application:** Online Reservation (e-marketmanager.net). For this application you just select what space you want, pay the fee, and give. You can also call them at (303)-289-4656. For both options, you must provide a summary of what you are selling and provide your contact information.
- **Application deadline:** None, you can access a space the day of, but it's recommended to reserve prior to the event in case of a lack of availability.
- What they are looking for: any products that you would like to sell and that fall within their guidelines.
- Requirements: If you have sold at the market more than five times in a year, you need a sales tax license. If you have sold less than five times then you just need to collect sales tax and submit a sales tax collection via an envelope that they will give to you.
- **Percentage of Sales:** n/a
- **Perks:** Huge space and chance to pitch your products to people that pass by your booth. You will have the ability to meet other vendors and learn and connect.

The Night Market will be at the Havana Exchange Shopping Center on June 17, and then Sam's No 3, 2580 S Havana St, Aurora, for July 15 and August 12.
- **Length:** Havana Global Market will be from 10am-2pm. The Night Market is from 5pm-9pm.
- **Vendor Application:** Become a vendor Market spread. You need to have an email or Facebook account to log in. The top of the application will have an option to select the type of vendor. You will select the youth vendor option. It will ask you to create a profile of your business and your contact information.
- **Application deadline:** n/a but fill out as soon as you can.
- What are they looking for: Products that represent the community you are a part of, handmade, ethically produced, and unique to who you are and what you represent.
- **Requirements:** Your products are your products- only handmade, nothing to be resold.
- Percentage of sales: 10% with a \$25 minimum
- **Perks:** Well organized event with a fun and exciting space for you to sell your products and experience a celebration of culture and community.

 - Daily vendors must pay a fee of \$100 at the end of the day. Contact them about setting up and what that entails.
